

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT CONCERNING TAXATION OF  
MOTOR VEHICLE FUEL AND SPECIAL FUEL BETWEEN THE SKOKOMISH  
INDIAN TRIBE AND THE STATE OF WASHINGTON**

The Skokomish Indian Tribe, a federally recognized Indian tribe, and the State of Washington agree to the following first amendment to the *Agreement Concerning Taxation of Motor Vehicle Fuel and Special Fuel between the Skokomish Indian Tribe and the State of Washington* that commenced on November 1, 2007 (hereinafter, the “Agreement”), pursuant to Section 6.2 of the Agreement:

***A new Section 2.4 is added to the Agreement, to read as follows:***

- 2.4 The parties recognize that, effective July 1, 2016, chapters 82.36 and 82.38 of the Revised Code of Washington were merged into a single chapter 82.38 that covers both motor vehicle fuel and special fuel, and that the numbering of some statutory provisions changed as of that date. The parties intend that references in this Agreement to particular sections of chapters 82.36 and 82.38 RCW will be understood to refer to their counterparts in the version of RCW 82.38 that took effect on July 1, 2016.

***Section 5.2 of the Agreement is amended as follows:***

- 5.2 The initial term of this Agreement shall commence November 1, 2007 and remain in effect until November 1, 2022, subject to automatic renewals. This Agreement shall automatically renew for successive terms of five years, unless either party serves an objection to the renewal in writing at least thirty (30) days prior to the expiration date of the then-current term.

***Section 6.7 of the Agreement is amended as follows:***

- 6.7 This Agreement shall commence November 1, 2007 and remain in effect in accordance with the provisions set forth in Section 5.2.

***Section 6.3 of the Agreement is amended as follows:***

- 6.3 The contact person for the Tribe, for any changes or concerns about this Agreement, shall be the Chair of the Skokomish Tribal Council. The contact person for the State, for any changes or concerns about this Agreement, shall be: Paul Johnson, Prorate and Fuel Tax Division.
